Sub: Proposal for Offering FTTH Services using Bharatnet Assets under Revenue Sharing Agreement  
Ref: [1] Corporate Letter No. BSNLCO-NPBB/11(13)/2/2020-NWP-BB-BSNL\_CO dated 27.04.2022

1. Kind attention is invited to the letter under reference wherein, to further boost the growth of FTTH services in Rural Areas using Bharatnet Assets, a comprehensive guidelines has been issued along with various approaches to provide the said services. The same is attached at Annexure A.
2. Two Specific Case Models viz (a) Case III A Bharatnet Rural and (b) Case IV Bharatnet Rural have been introduced to offer the said services. The revenue share between BSNL and prospective partner for Case III A Bharatnet Rural shall be 70:30 while for Case IV Bharatnet Rural shall be 50:50.
3. In case III A Bharatnet Rural, existing Bharatnet OLT shall be used. This shall be used only in exceptional scenario where few connections are required at GP location or new OLT location (directly from PON port using BSNL / TIP ONT). This is shown in the last scenario in the document, different approaches to connect BSNL Franchise OLT with Bharat Net Network. The same is attached as Annex-III of Corporate letter at Ref[1].
4. In majority of the cases, which comes under Case IV Bharatnet Rural, the partner has to install its new OLT and BSNL has to integrate using existing Bharatnet Assets / Transmission N/w / NIB Network. The same is also indicated in the various scenario (except the last one) in the document, different approaches to connect BSNL Franchise OLT with Bharat Net Network.
5. Further, the partner does not have to pay any Charges (As were being paid to BSNL till 31-03- 2022 for its infrastructure used under Case IVA BSNL as was instructed vide corporate office letter E-file BSNLCO-NPBB/11(13)/2/2020-NWP-BB-BSNL\_CO dated 11.02.2020.)
6. The copy of the agreement detailing various terms and conditions is attached at Annexure B.
7. The agreement shall be done block wise on non exclusive basis. The preference shall be given to local residents of that block /Gram Panchayat / Village.
8. All prospective partners are hereby requested to be a part of this mission and join the ever growing BSNL for FTTH partners and contribute towards proliferation of FTTH services simultaneously earning a handsome share. They may submit their proposal along with signed copy of PAN, GST, Aadhaar to the nearest OA / BA office.
9. The respective BSNL office has also been asked to take up the case on priority and ensure faster onboarding of FTTH partners. In case of any issue, this office be also contacted at., following numbers.

1. Kindly refer DOT office memorandum no 30-406/ Bharatnet/USOF/2019(pt) Dated at Sanchar Bhawan, New Delhi 28.03.2022, **(Annex-I)** vide which it is mandated that Bharat Net assets are to be utilized / monetised. Circles have already taken over the Bharat Net assets for O & M activities w.e.f. 01-04-2022.
2. In this regard BSNL is already providing FTTH services under various revenue share models. After deliberations with few circles, following new revenue share models using Bharat Net assets in rural areas are decided to be made effective immediately so as to speed up the on-boarding of the partners in the rural area:

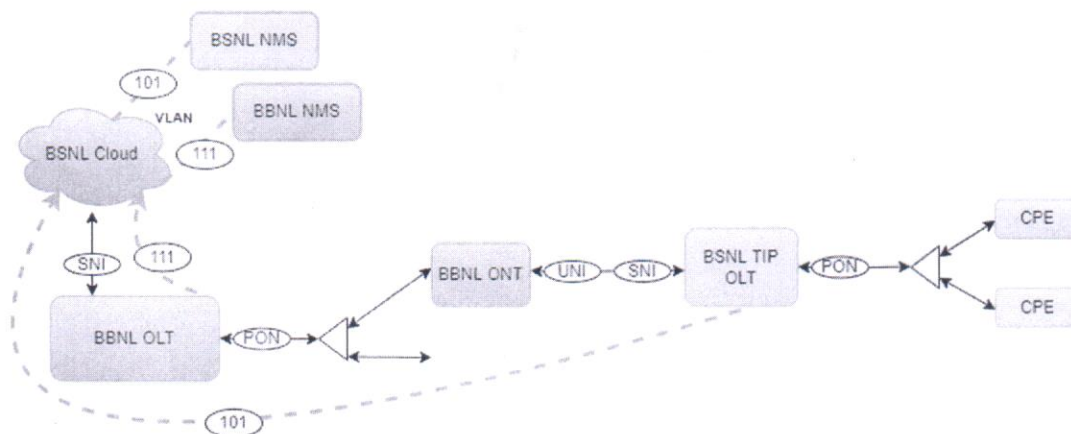
3. **The partner does not have to pay any Charges (As were being paid to BBNL till 31-03-2022 for its infrastructure used under Case IVA BBNL as was instructed vide this office letter E-file BSNLCO-NPBB/11(13)/2/2020-NWP-BB-BSNL\_CO dated 11.02.2020.) (Annex-II). Case IVA BBNL, revenue share model is discontinued with immediate effect.**
4. Further such FTTH connections shall be separately tagged in FMS so that revenue can be accounted separately for Bharat Net assets.
5. Thus Circles are requested to immediately on-board partners for providing FTTH connections by using Bharat Net assets under the revenue share module Case-IIIA Bharat Net Rural and Case-IV Bharat Net Rural as in para-2 table. Different approaches to connect BSNL Franchise OLT with Bharat Net Network is attached as **Annex-III for reference.**
6. Customers already working in Case IVA BBNL shall be migrated to Case IV Bharat Net Rural.
7. **As the case for further assistance to Bharat Net utilization is already under discussion with USOF, BSNL will make suitable addendum to this agreement of Case IIIA Bharat Net Rural and Case IV Bharat Net Rural, once the assistance is approved by USOF.**

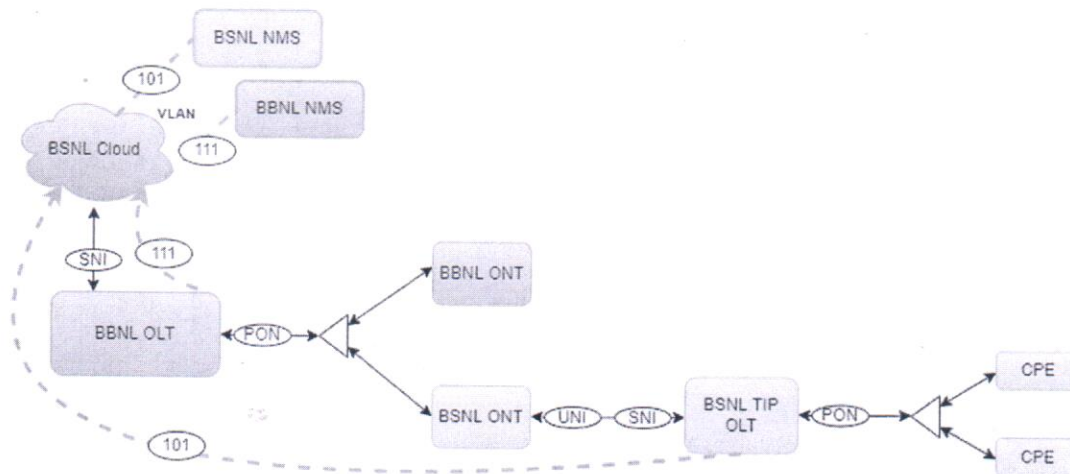
## Different approaches to connect BSNL Franchise OLT with BBNL Network

## GP Level connections through BharatNet ONTs



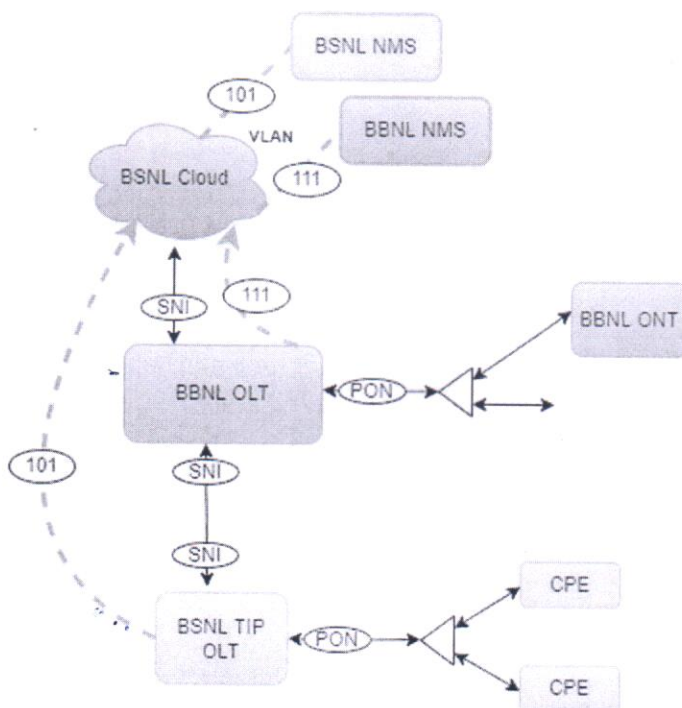
1. In this scenario, BBNL OLT & BBNL ONT will be used.
2. BBNL OLT & ONT will pass the VLANs (Service & Management traffic) transparently from BSNL backhaul to the BSNL TIP OLT.
3. Configurations required at BBNL OLT & BBNL ONT will be done from BBNL NMS by the BBNL NOC team.
4. Configurations at BSNL BNG & TIP OLT will be done by BSNL team
5. Number of VLANs that can be passed in the 3 technologies of BharatNet OLTs is under testing
6. BSNL & BBNL OLTs will be managed by their respective NMSs.

## GP Level connections through BSNL ONTs



1. In this scenario, BBNL OLT will be used.
2. BBNL OLT & BSNL ONT will pass the VLANs (Service & Management traffic) transparently from BSNL backhaul to the BSNL TIP OLT.
3. Configurations required at BBNL OLT & BSNL ONT will be done from BBNL NMS by the BBNL NOC team.
4. Configurations at BSNL BNG & TIP OLT will be done by BSNL team
5. Number of VLANs that can be passed in the 3 technologies of BharatNet OLTs is under testing
6. Number of VLANs that can be passed in the BSNL ONT to be checked
7. BSNL & BBNL OLTs will be managed by their respective NMSs.
8. BSNL ONT should be compatible with the BBNL OLT

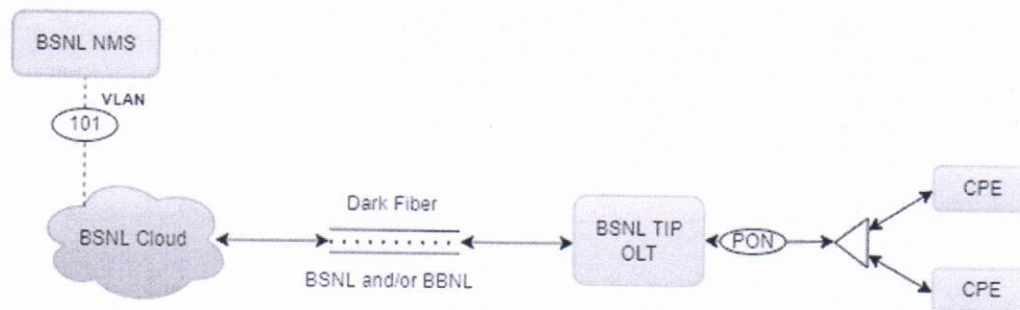
## Block/GP level connections through partner OLTs cascaded with BBNL OLT for SNI



1. In this scenario, BBNL OLT will be used.
2. BBNL OLT will pass the VLANs (Service & Management traffic) transparently from BSNL backhaul to the BSNL TIP OLT.
3. Configurations required at BBNL OLT will be done from BBNL NMS by the BBNL NOC team
4. Configurations at BSNL BNG & TIP OLT will be done by BSNL team
5. There is no limitation on the number of VLANs that can be passed. VLANs used in BBNL & BSNL TIP OLT should be mutually exclusive.
6. BSNL & BBNL OLTs will be managed by their respective NMSs.
7. SNI port availability at BBNL OLT to be checked. For each BSNL TIP OLT, separate SNI port is required at the BBNL OLT

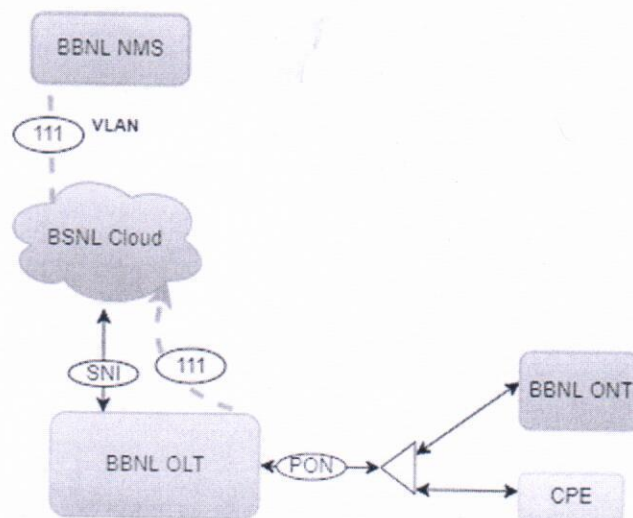


### Block/GP level connections through partner OLT utilizing BBNL Dark Fiber

WHERE AS BSNL is in the business of providing Basic Telephony Services, Cellular Mobile Telephony Services (CMTS), Internet & broadband services and National Long Distance Services (NLDS) in its licensed areas of operation in the geographical territory of India.

AND WHEREAS BSNL Corporate Office has issued a policy guidelines vide letter No. BSNLCO-NPBB/11(13)/2/2020-NWP-BB-BSNL\_CO dated 27.04.2022 regarding immediate onboarding of BSNL partners on Bharatnet Assets

AND WHEREAS BSNL BIHAR CIRCLE has invited proposal for Onboarding of Partners using Bharatnet Assets under Revenue Sharing Agreement vide letter No CGMT/Bihar/Bharatnet/2022-23/01 dated. 07/05/2022”.

AND WHEREAS M/s ..... , has offered its willingness to BSNL to become FTTH partners to provide FTTH service to the residents of Areas of Operations (**Refer Clause 9.0 of Agreement**) and has agreed to the proposal of BSNL based on the terms and conditions contained herein.

**NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:**

1. In consideration of the due observance and performance of all the terms & conditions of this agreement, the BSNL and TIP agree to sign this agreement on non-exclusive and revenue sharing basis to provide the BSNL telecom services.
2. TIP agrees that the infrastructure provided by BSNL will be utilized for exclusively for BSNL services only.
3. TIP shall ensure the execution of services as per this agreement and continuance of the same by the future association / any other outside agency who may continue to maintain the telecom and other services in the residential complex / commercial complex for the entire agreement period.

**4. Model Case IIIA BharatNet Rural:**

## **6.0 Bill issue & collection:**

- 6.1 BSNL shall be solely responsible for all commercial functions of bill issue and its collection for the telecom services provided to customers under this agreement. The services shall be billed as part of telecom services provided by BSNL. The bills will be raised and collected by BSNL from the subscribers.
- 6.2 TIP shall not charge any money from the customers. No additional services other than those contained within the scope of this agreement shall be provided to the customers of BSNL either free or for a cost without the written approval of BSNL.
- 6.3 All deposits levies, including security deposits collected on account of CPE /STB /ONT provided by BSNL / registration amounts as decided by BSNL, shall be billed and collected by BSNL and no revenue share shall be payable to TIP from such receipts.
- 6.4 The terms and conditions of payments by customers shall be governed by BSNL's rules from time to time. The disconnection and resolution practice from payment defaulters shall be enforced.

## **7. Revenue share payment process:**

- 7.1 Revenue sharing will be on overall realized revenue excluding taxes. (i.e. including Rental/FMC and Usage).
- 7.2 All the customers falling under the purview of this agreement shall be identified separately and the revenue share may be paid to the TIP as per the terms & conditions of this agreement for such customers.
- 7.3 The payment of revenue share to the TIP will be made by BSNL by 28th of the following month in which the revenue is realized.
- 7.4 The payment of revenue share shall be made to the TIP after the deduction of applicable statutory levies which includes license fees payable by BSNL and / or taxes applicable from time to time, from the revenues accrued on account of provision of telecom services under the agreement. All such taxes / levies shall be a pass-through item and shall be billed to and collected from the customers and paid to the respective statutory bodies by BSNL, except such cases where liabilities arise on account of claims raised by concerned authorities in a post-facto manner, wherein such liability shall be shared in the same ratio as the revenue share for the respective services.
- 7.5 Any discrepancy found would be mutually discussed and resolved. Balance of payments arising due to any reason shall be adjusted in future payments by BSNL

10. All commercial documents viz. CAF etc. shall be collected by TIP and filled in CAF to be forwarded to BSNL and all customers shall be BSNL customers. BSNL shall collect dues payable to it by the individual residents / commercial complex occupants of “Projects in the Annexure” directly from such subscribers / residents. TIP shall not in any way be liable or responsible for the non-payment or delayed payment of the dues to BSNL, by the individual subscribers residing in “Projects in annexure”.

**11. General Conditions:**

1. This agreement is applicable for FTTH services using BharatNet Assests in Rural Areas.)
2. This agreement is a confidential document. The TIP shall not divulge any part of the agreement either through oral or written communication or through any other mode to any third party.
3. This agreement shall not be amended or modified or altered or changed in any way except in writing and duly executed by the authorized representatives of each party.
4. **Period of agreement:** This agreement shall be valid for the period of 10 years from the date of signing and is renewable thereafter on similar / mutually agreed terms and conditions.
5. **(A) Termination of the agreement:** This agreement may be terminated by, giving one month’s notice to FTTH partners.
  - a. Failure to Commission the equipment and /or execution of the work at all by the TIP within three months from signing of the agreement
  - b. Failure to perform any other obligation/s under the contract: and
  - c. Equipment does not perform satisfactory in the field in accordance with the specifications.
  - d. Failure to meet the SLA parameters continuously for three months.
  - e. Agreement may also be terminated by mutual, written consent of the both parties by giving three months” notices. On termination of agreement, the customers shall continue to use the Telecom Services of BSNL, through commissioned equipment under the contract.

**(B) Sub Contract:** The FTTH partners shall notify BSNL all subcontract awarded under these contracts if already specified during signing of the agreement. Such notification shall not relieve the FTTH partners from any liability or obligation under the contract.

**(C) EMS:**

- a. Under Model IV, Franchisee shall provide, install and operate only those OLTs for which EMS has been installed by the OEM. No bandwidth and Colocation charges shall be levied by BSNL for EMS servers.
  - b. EMS shall be tested during the integration with BSNL network. EMS shall manage both OLT and ONTs. The interconnection of a disaster recovers EMS with main EMS and its manual switch over shall be tested during the testing.
  - c. Further, open protocol shall be supplied as the North bound interface along with suitable network interface and software in the EMS.
  - d. The format for the reporting from EMS shall be finalized by BSNL.
6. **Non-Disclosure Agreement:** Format of non-disclosure undertaking shall be signed by the Franchisee.
7. **Severability:** Should TRAI / DoT declare any part of this agreement unenforceable through direction / order / regulation or if terms of license of BSNL are changed through any amendment or order of the Government, the parties will cooperate and take all appropriate steps to amend, modify or alter this agreement.
8. This agreement shall be binding upon all respective successors of the parties.
9. Revenue sharing shall be from overall realized revenue (i.e. including rental/FMC and usage, excluding Taxes). The detail revenue share model is given in table 1

below and will be as per BSNL corporate office /Circle office instructions as revised from time to time which will be binding to partner.

## **12. Compliance of laws:**

BSNL and TIP shall perform their duties in strict compliance with all applicable laws in India along with rules and regulations of the duly constituted Govt. authorities in India and shall obtain all licenses, restrictions or other approval, if any, required by laws in India in connection with the services to be rendered hereunder.

Further, service provided to the customers shall be subject to Indian Telegraph Act 1885, TRAI directions and tariff circulars issued by BSNL Corporate Office.

## **13. Indemnification:**

TIP agrees to protect, defend, indemnify and hold harmless BSNL and its employees, officers, directors, agents or representatives from and against any and all liabilities, damages, fines, penalties and costs (including legal costs and disbursements) arising from or relating to:

(a) Any breach of any statute, regulation, direction, orders or standards from any governmental body, agency, telecommunications operator or regulator applicable to such party; "or"

(b) Any breach of the terms and conditions in this agreement by the TIP.

**14. Relationship:** Each party understands that it is an independently owned business entity and this agreement does not make it, its employees, associates or agents as employees, agents or legal representatives of the other party for any purpose whatsoever. Neither party has express or implied right or authority to assume or to undertake any obligation in respect of or on behalf of or in the name of the other party or to bind the other party in any manner. In case, any party, its employees, associates or agents hold out as employees, agents, or legal representatives of the other party, the former party shall forthwith upon demand make good any / all loss, cost, damage including consequential loss, suffered by the other party on this account.

## **15. ARBITRATION**

15.1 In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under this agreement or in connection therewith (except as to the matters, the decision to which is specifically provided under this agreement), the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the CGMT, BSNL Bihar Telecom Circle or in case his designation is changed or his office is abolished, then in such cases to the sole arbitration of the officer for the time being entrusted (whether in addition to his own duties or otherwise) with the functions of the CGMT, BSNL Bihar Telecom Circle or by whatever designation such an officer may be called (hereinafter referred to as the said officer), and if the CGMT, BSNL Bihar Telecom Circle or the said officer is unable or unwilling to act as such, then to the sole arbitration of some other person appointed by the CGMT, BSNL Bihar Telecom Circle or the said officer. The agreement to appoint an arbitrator will be in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. There will be no objection to any such appointment on the ground that the arbitrator is a Government Servant or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as a Government Servant he has expressed his views on all or any of the matters in dispute. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties to the agreement. In the event of such an arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred, being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason whatsoever, the CGMT, BSNL Bihar Telecom Circle or the said officer shall appoint another person to act as an arbitrator in accordance with terms of the agreement and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed from the stage at which it was left out by his predecessors.

15.2 The arbitrator may from time to time with the consent of both the parties enlarge the time frame for making and publishing the award. Subject to the aforesaid, Arbitration and

Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under, any modification thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.

15.3 The venue of the arbitration proceeding shall be the office of the CGMT, BSNL Bihar Telecom Circle or such other places as the arbitrator may decided.
